Presidents Report – Presented

1. Team Pennants, due to COVID-19 restrictions the Tues competition is once again suspended for 6 weeks, and is due to restart on 6th Oct. Semi-finals and finals should complete around middle of November. If restarting the competition is delayed, we would look at 'first past' the post, in lieu of final series.
2. Closed Championships – targeted for late November, if pennants complete on time
3. Tues Night Umpire – Peter Lazell international umpire to continue to come Tuesday evenings to watch matches and check players serves. Also should observe the table tennis play at St Mark Church
4. Players representing the State of NSW – Nil for 2020, due to COVID-19, as all national and international competitions have been cancelled. Jonathan Tan played at the INAS Brisbane Games in October 2019. Michelle Bromley and Chris Yan has been selected to play in 2020 Tokyo Olympics games when the games begin next year on 23 July, 2021
5. Thursday Active Table Tennis – is held 9:30am – 11.30am at HALC, has been attracting 15-20 players
6. Friday Night Social & PMA Table Tennis – is at 7:30pm – 9:30pm, prior to COVID-19 tables opened for social play ranged between 12-15 tables. Currently with the pandemic, books have approximately halved. PMA Table Tennis occupies 10 tables on the other half of the basketball court.
