



Notice to all players Changes that may impact you...

- **1. 3RD Place Medals**: Awarded to teams finishing 3rd place finish in the finals
- 2. Rating Central: Recommended Rating Central ratings per grade

3. Serves: An umpire will be available on the night should you have any queries with a players serve during your game. According to the laws of table tennis 2.6.2 states on ball toss:

"The server shall then project ball near vertically upwards, without imparting spin, so that it rises at least 16cm (6.3 inches) after leaving the palm of the free hand and then falls without touching anything before being struck"

4. Player Substitution: If you are not able to form a full team on the night, a substitute player can be selected from the <u>approved reserve list</u>, from the equivalent grade or a lower grade, enabling points won by the player to be counted.

If your player has been substituted from <u>any other team</u> (including from the same grade or a lower grade) registered in the 2020 Summer Pennants, any points won by the substitute <u>player will not be counted.</u>

If your substitute player is <u>not registered</u> to play in the 2020 Summer Pennants, any points won by the substitute <u>player will not be counted.</u>

 Reserve Players List: Players must be registered with TTNSW with District level registration (\$70) to be eligible to be on the reserve list.
